

Join the Clean Heat Rhode Island HPIN

Rhode Island Energy Participating Contractors will be temporarily enrolled in the Clean Heat Rhode Island HPIN starting on the program launch date. Within three months, Participating Contractors must provide the necessary documentation and sign the agreement to remain enrolled in the Clean Heat Rhode Island HPIN.

REQUIRED TRAINING:

Within the first year of participation, all primary installers must provide a certificate of completion for training provided by a heat pump manufacturer.

- EPA Section 608 Technician Certification, Type I, II or Universal Refrigerant Handling Certification
- Signed copy of Participating Contractor Agreement
- Certificate of Comprehensive General Liability Insurance
- A Master plumber license if installing heat pump water heaters
- A Master 1 or 2 refrigerant license
- W-9
